5 at East Texas State University, earning a master's degree in

12 loved to visit new places, and after retiring, she and her husband
13 traveled in their recreational vehicle to 48 states; she delighted

16 Risinger also welcomed into her family two grandsons, Cole and
17 Cade; she was predeceased by her husband in 1992; and

18 WHEREAS, Robbie Risinger possessed a generosity of spirit
19 that expressed itself in myriad ways, and countless lives were
20 touched by her warmth and kindness; now, therefore, be it
