WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Bondurant married in her hometown and 19 moved to Arlington; over the course of the couple's 68 years 20 21 together, they became the proud parents of 6 children, Sherry, Terrie, Chrissie, Rick, Sandy, and Barry, and shared in the joy of 22 23 welcoming into their family 28 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren; and 24
