12 WHEREAS, Mr. Frazier entered the army in 1942 and served in 13 Alexandria, Louisiana, where he was trained in the medical corps; 14 following his discharge in 1945, he returned to farming before 15 going to work for Mr. and Mrs. James T. Bowers of Dallas; he managed 16 their busy household while their six children were small and became 17 a beloved member of the family, ultimately serving for more than 40 18 years before his retirement; and

WHEREAS, A longtime congregant of Bethlehem Baptist Church, Mr. Frazier served as a deacon and as president of the usher board; in his retirement, he has helped maintain the church as well as homes and yards in the surrounding neighborhood; today, when he is not helping others, he works in his own yard and enjoys relaxing in his front porch swing; and
