1 WHEREAS, The 85th birthday of an esteemed Texan is truly
2 cause for celebration, and Juandelle Wainscott Lacy Roberts of
3 Midland is marking this notable milestone in her life on January 23,
4 2013; and

5 WHEREAS, The daughter of the Reverend and Mrs. C. E.
6 Wainscott, the former Juandelle Wainscott was born in 1928 in
7 Quitaque; she performed her first solo at the age of three and has
8 maintained a love of music throughout her life, supporting
9 symphonies wherever she lives and hosting an annual Christmas
10 sing-along event; and

11 WHEREAS, In 1945, she married James W. Lacy, with whom she
12 raised two children; the philanthropic couple supported Baptist and
13 other evangelical missionary work across the Americas, Africa,
14 Eastern Europe, and Asia and funded a school for gypsy children in
15 Romania; moreover, they began the Excalibur Round Table that
16 benefits cancer research and established the Wainscott-Lacy
17 Memorial Fund scholarship program for students at Baptist schools
18 and an engineering scholarship for students at Texas Tech
19 University; and

20 WHEREAS, Following the death of Mr. Lacy, she was fortunate
21 enough to find love again in her marriage with W. V. "Red" Roberts;

23 WHEREAS, A woman of strong convictions, Mrs. Roberts has been
24 a staunch supporter of the Republican Party for more than 55 years,

1 and she has worked for the GOP across three states; a member of the
2 prestigious Texas Federation of Republican Women, she was elected
3 to serve the party as Tulsa County chair; over the years, she has
4 worked on countless political campaigns, and she even once mentored
5 a young George W. Bush when he ran for state office; and

6 WHEREAS, Juandelle Roberts is a source of joy and inspiration
7 to her family and friends, and it is a pleasure to honor her on eight
8 and a half decades of life well lived; now, therefore, be it
