opened on the land in 1884, and in 1886, a town was laid out and

12 named Kennedale, after Mr. Kennedy; that same year, the Fort Worth

and New Orleans Railway built a line through the town to Waxahachie, 13

14 along with a passenger depot and several section houses as

residences for its employees; during that era, the town became 15

16 known for its brickworks, and Kennedale brick was used in several

buildings in Fort Worth; and 17

18 WHEREAS, Today, Kennedale is an attractive and comfortable community with easy access to the amenities of Fort Worth and 19 20 Arlington; residents and visitors alike enjoy the opportunities for 21 recreation available at Rodgers Farm Park and Sonora Park, and a replica of one of the original railway section houses stands at 22 23 TownCenter Park to provide a colorful reminder of the city's
