WHEREAS, An important center of higher education in South 10 11 Texas since 1925, Texas A&M University--Kingsville includes the 12 Frank H. Dotterweich College of Engineering, the Dick and Mary Lewis Kleberg College of Agriculture, the Caesar Kleberg Wildlife 13 14 Research Institute, and the Irma Lerma Rangel College of Pharmacy; the university has claimed seven national football championships 15 16 and has recently been recognized for its excellent environmental engineering program, jazz band, and wildlife society; this fine 17 18 institution continues to see enrollment increase every year and has opened a new dormitory and student recreation center, with 19 20 construction on a new dining facility under way; and

21 WHEREAS, Naval Air Station Kingsville features the premier 22 undergraduate pilot training facility in the United States, which 23 prepares U.S. Navy and Marine Corps pilots for their key role in 24 national defense; in recent years, the base has added an Army
