RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Organizing members of the Bosque River Valley 2 Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution are gathering 3 on February 2, 2013, for the inaugural meeting of their group; and

WHEREAS, Established in 1890, the Daughters of the American Revolution is a nonprofit organization dedicated to preserving American history, promoting patriotism, and advancing education for all; the DAR puts these principles into practice through a wide variety of activities, such as assisting veterans, providing scholarships, and supporting underserved schools; and

WHEREAS, Charter members of the Bosque River Valley Chapter of the DAR selected the name of their group because of the river's significance to early settlers in the area; beginning in the mid-1800s, pioneer communities sprang up along the banks of the Bosque, and the abundant resources associated with the river proved essential to their survival; and

16 WHEREAS, More than 30 women have joined together to organize 17 the Bosque River Valley Chapter, among them the founding officers, 18 regent Sue Moore Fielden; vice-regent Phyllis Alford Olson; 19 chaplain Therissa Crabtree Young; recording secretary Ruth Ann 20 Nelson Crawford; corresponding secretary MaryLynn Murphey Haynes; 21 treasurer Ann Groom Lenz; registrar Naomi Young Nabors; historian 22 Marilyn Maxwell Holland; and librarian Betty Urban Johannes; and

23 WHEREAS, By establishing a local chapter of the DAR, the 24 members of this group have demonstrated a notable commitment to
