1 WHEREAS, The residents of Nacogdoches lost one of their most 2 esteemed community leaders with the death of Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital CEO Tim Hayward on January 5, 2013, at the age of 49; and 3 WHEREAS, Born in Bristol, Pennsylvania, on January 10, 1963, 4 5 Tim Hayward was a graduate of Katy High School and Stephen F. Austin State University, where he joined Theta Chi Fraternity; initially 6 7 drawn to the field of education, he earned his bachelor's degree in that discipline; and 8 9 WHEREAS, During his freshman year at SFA, Mr. Hayward began 10 working at Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital as

phlebotomist; he continued as a member of the hospital staff after 11 12 his graduation, serving as a certified medical technologist and later as director of infection control and of utilization and risk 13 management; in 2000, he assumed the office of CEO; and

14 WHEREAS, Under his leadership, Nacogdoches Memorial Hospital 15 16 experienced notable progress, achieving certification as a Level Three Trauma Center, becoming a Joint Commission Certified Stroke 17 Center, and earning accreditation for its Chest Pain Center; in 18 addition, Mr. Hayward oversaw the opening of a new ICU/ER tower and 19 pioneered outreach programs designed to expand the hospital's 20 21 service to the community; he created the Healthy Nacogdoches Coalition, which was instrumental in the city's selection as a 22 23 Heart and Stroke Healthy City by the Texas Department of State Health Services, and he collaborated with a range of 24

- 1 government groups to form the Rural East Texas Health Network for
- 2 Mental Health Transformation; along the way, he distinguished
- 3 himself as a caring and generous leader, earning the respect of his
- 4 staff and area medical professionals; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Mr. Hayward was the loving husband of Laura Hayward,
- 6 with whom he shared 28 years, and the proud father of three
- 7 children, Samantha, Sara, and Patrick; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Deeply devoted to his family and his community, Tim
- 9 Hayward made a meaningful difference in the lives of his loved ones
- 10 and fellow citizens alike, and although his time on this earth ended
- 11 far too soon, he leaves behind a legacy that will be treasured for
- 12 years to come; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 14 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Tim Hayward and
- 15 extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife,

- 18 sisters, Kim and Kristina; and to his other relatives and many
