

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Residents of Cedar Park greatly benefited from the
2 leadership of mayor and former city council member Bob Lemon, who
3 concluded his tenure in May 2012; and

4 WHEREAS, Bob Lemon was first elected to the Cedar Park City
5 Council in 1995, serving as mayor pro tempore from 1997 to 1999; in
6 2005, he returned to public service and successfully ran for mayor
7 of Cedar Park; and

8 WHEREAS, During his terms both as mayor and as a member of the
9 city council, this esteemed Texan worked to foster economic growth
10 and to improve transportation and infrastructure during a period
11 when Cedar Park's population rose from less than 15,000 to some
12 54,000; moreover, he oversaw a number of major developments,
13 including the Cedar Park Center arena and the Cedar Park Regional
14 Medical Center; and

15 WHEREAS, In addition to his service in municipal government,
16 Mayor Lemon has participated in the Williamson County Senate
17 District No. 25 Convention and the Texas Republican State
18 Convention; he has also served as a board member of the Cedar Park
19 Chamber of Commerce, as a member of the Cedar Park Athletics and
20 Fellowship of Christian Athletes booster clubs, and as president
21 and vice president of the Buttercup Creek Homeowners Association;

23 WHEREAS, Since 1977, Bob Lemon has enjoyed a successful
24 career as a software engineer; in all his endeavors, he enjoys the

1 support of his wife, Patti, who is also highly active in the
2 community, and the couple take great pride in their three
3 daughters, Grace, Faith, and Rachael Hope; and

4 WHEREAS, Mayor Lemon has distinguished himself through his
5 outstanding record of public service and civic engagement, and in
6 so doing, he has helped to make Cedar Park an even better place to
7 live and work; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
9 Legislature hereby commend Bob Lemon for his contributions to the
10 city of Cedar Park and extend to him sincere best wishes for the
11 future; and, be it further

12 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
