

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, For more than 45 years, the DFW Humane Society has
2 dedicated itself to caring for homeless and abandoned animals in
3 the Dallas/Fort Worth metropolitan area; and

4 WHEREAS, Founded in 1967, the DFWHS is a no-kill animal
5 shelter that houses stray and unwanted pets and arranges for their
6 adoption into new homes; it also works with the Texas Coalition for
7 Animal Protection and the Kaufman County Animal Awareness Project
8 to provide low-cost spay and neuter services; the shelter houses
9 between 80 and 100 animals at any one time and relies on donations
10 and the assistance of dedicated volunteers; and

11 WHEREAS, The DFWHS formed an association with Irving Animal
12 Services in 2007, and since 2010, this unique public/private
13 partnership has shared the same facility in Irving; working
14 together, the two groups have rescued animals living in unsanitary
15 households, provided homes for pets made homeless by natural
16 disasters, and conducted such joint community programs as mobile
17 adoptions, Pooch Fest, the Blessing of the Animals, and Wags and
18 Whiskers Week; and

19 WHEREAS, By offering a safe shelter for abandoned pets and
20 working to find each one a loving permanent home, the skilled and
21 compassionate people of the DFW Humane Society truly deserve
22 special recognition for the invaluable service they provide; now,
23 therefore, be it
