WHEREAS, Citizens from Denton County are gathering in Austin on February 19, 2013, to celebrate Denton County Day at the State Capitol; and

WHEREAS, Located in North Texas, Denton County was created by the Texas Legislature in 1846 and named for pioneer preacher, lawyer, and soldier John Bunyan Denton; the early years of the county saw its emergence as an agricultural center, and the arrival of the railroads in the 1880s ensured that the area's wheat and cotton would find distribution across the country; and

WHEREAS, The county has witnessed remarkable growth in recent years, as its population tripled over the past two decades, and in 2012, Money magazine listed it among the top 10 places to live because of its excellent economy; and

WHEREAS, Denton is home to the University of North Texas and Texas Woman's University, which were founded as Texas Normal College and Girls' Industrial College in 1890 and 1903, respectively, as well as a campus of North Central Texas College, and the alumni of these schools have gone on to make their mark on the history of Texas and the nation; and

WHEREAS, Further attractions in the area include the beauty of the North Texas Greenbelt, the architecture of the Denton County Courthouse-on-the-Square, and the action of the Texas Motor Speedway; and

WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich history even as they work to
