## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Residents of Garland have greatly benefited from the 2 leadership of Rick Williams, who has served as a city council member 3 for three terms; and

WHEREAS, Elected to the city council in 2007, Mr. Williams was chosen the following year to serve as mayor pro tempore; during his six years on the council, he has chaired the audit committee and represented Garland in the Emergency Preparedness Department of the North Central Texas Council of Governments; and
