RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, On the morning of February 1, 2003, the NASA space 2 shuttle *Columbia* broke apart in the skies over Texas, taking the 3 lives of its entire crew; the 10th anniversary of that tragedy 4 provides a fitting occasion to pay tribute to those seven 5 astronauts and to reflect on their heroism and sacrifice; and

6 WHEREAS, Hailing from across the nation and around the world, 7 the crew of the STS-107 mission exemplified the highest ideals of the astronaut corps; crew commander Rick D. Husband was a native of 8 Amarillo and a U.S. Air Force colonel with more than 3,800 hours of 9 flight time in over 40 different types of aircraft; he had 10 previously served as pilot on the STS-96 Discovery mission, when 11 12 the first docking with the International Space Station was accomplished; and 13

14 WHEREAS, Pilot William McCool was a graduate of Coronado High School in Lubbock and the son of a Marine and naval aviator; he 15 16 followed in his father's footsteps by becoming a pilot in the U.S. Navy; payload commander Michael P. Anderson, a lieutenant colonel 17 in the U.S. Air Force, had flown on the space shuttle Endeavour with 18 the STS-89 mission; born in Karnal, India, mission specialist 19 20 Kalpana Chawla held a doctorate in aerospace engineering and had 21 earlier served aboard Columbia on the STS-87 mission; and

22 WHEREAS, Mission specialist David M. Brown was a captain in 23 the U.S. Navy, a physician, and a fighter pilot; U.S. Navy captain 24 Laurel B. Clark was a mission specialist with previous experience

1 as a submarine medical officer and as a flight surgeon; payload 2 specialist Ilan Ramon was a colonel in the Israeli Air Force, where 3 he had excelled in his duties as a fighter pilot and squadron 4 commander; and

5 WHEREAS, This team of extraordinarily gifted men and women made invaluable contributions to science, engineering, and the 6 history of spaceflight while furthering the tradition 7 of 8 international cooperation that was a hallmark of the shuttle program; through their courageous endeavors, they earned a place 9 among the great explorers of history, individuals who sought, in 10 the words of the poet Alfred Tennyson, "to strive, to seek, to find, 11 and not to yield"; now, therefore, be it 12

13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas 14 Legislature hereby commemorate the 10th anniversary of the STS-107 15 Columbia mission and pay tribute to the memory of its valiant crew.
