WHEREAS, Mr. Basye 13 loves to tell stories about his 14 experiences in Germany during World War II and his subsequent return to the United States, as well as about his youth in the 15 1920s, including his memory of riding the train to Washington, 16 D.C., and seeing Herbert Hoover sworn in as president; he returned 17 to the nation's capital in 2012, when he was honored along with 18 about 40 other North Texas veterans with a two-day trip to 19 20 Washington, paid for as part of a veterans appreciation effort; and 21 WHEREAS, Raymond Basye has witnessed a panorama of historic change over the course of nearly a century, and it is a pleasure to 22 23 join in recognizing him on a life well lived; now, therefore, be it
