- 14 has included training as a photo equipment repairman and as an
- 15 aircraft loadmaster, a specialty for which he held instructor
- 16 certification; he also completed training in such areas as disaster
- 17 management and terrorism response; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Among the awards and citations bestowed on this
- 19 distinguished Texan over the years have been the Meritorious
- 20 Service Medal, the Air Force Achievement Medal, two Good Conduct
- 21 Medals, the Lone Star Distinguished Service Medal, and the Senior
- 22 Aircrew Badge; and
- 23 WHEREAS, In civilian life, Sergeant Major Kirk has been
- 24 employed in pipe and vessel fabrication; he is a Mason and also a

- 2 Spring with his wife, Georgia Marie; and
