

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The city of Lufkin lost one of its most admired
2 residents with the passing of Raymond Moore on October 10, 2012, at
3 the age of 73; and

4 WHEREAS, A Lufkin native, Mr. Moore was born on February 14,
5 1939, to Lloyd and Virginia Moore; he earned a degree in civil
6 engineering from Texas Tech University, and while in college, he
7 married the former Jan Norris; the couple subsequently settled in
8 Mr. Moore's hometown, where he went to work for his family's
9 business, Moore Brothers Construction Company; and

10 WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan became a leader in his
11 profession, serving as president of the board of directors of the
12 Texas Hot Mix Asphalt Pavement Association and as a valued member of
13 the Highway, Heavy, Utilities and Industrial Branch of the
14 Associated General Contractors of Texas; along the way, he pursued
15 a part-time career in Angus cattle breeding, and he benefited the
16 industry in his roles as president of the East Texas Angus
17 Association from 1982 to 1985 and as president of the Texas Angus
18 Association later that decade; Mr. Moore was inducted into the
19 Texas Angus Association Hall of Fame in 2006, and after retiring the
20 following year as executive vice president of Moore Brothers, he
21 turned his focus to breeding Angus cattle full-time; and

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Moore further distinguished himself through his
23 community involvement; he was the longtime chair of Angelina
24 Savings Bank, which he helped found, and he was instrumental in the

1 creation of the Angelina County Exposition Center and took pleasure
2 in supporting its youth fair; in addition, he was among the local
3 leaders who formed the Lufkin Roundtable, an organization that
4 promotes the city and funds annual scholarships for graduating
5 seniors in Angelina County; he was the recipient of the Angelina
6 Award in 1992 for his achievements in behalf of the county; and

7 WHEREAS, Preceded in death by his first wife, Mr. Moore was
8 fortunate to find love again with Carol Anderson, and the couple
9 shared a rewarding marriage together; Mr. Moore was also the proud
10 father of three sons, Alan, David, and Brian; and

11 WHEREAS, Raymond Moore contributed to the lives of his fellow
12 citizens in myriad ways, and he leaves behind a legacy that will
13 forever be treasured by all those who were privileged to know him;
14 now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
16 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the memory of Raymond Moore and
17 extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife,
18 Carol Moore; to his sons, Alan Moore and his wife, Kathey, David
19 Moore and his wife, Kelley, and Brian Moore; to his stepsons, Doug
20 McKelvey and his wife, Kathy, and Brad McKelvey and his wife, Jana;
21 to his grandchildren, Kimberly Graham and her husband, Aaron, Maci
22 Jan Moore, Ben Beaty, and Abigail Irene Moore; to his
23 step-grandchildren, Lauren, Kyle, Brandon, Brock, Penn, and
24 Scarlet McKelvey; to his brother, Jerry Moore, and his wife, Carol;
