1 WHEREAS, The members of the Muenster Jaycees are celebrating
2 50 years of supporting their community on February 23, 2013; and

3 WHEREAS, Since its founding in 1963, the group has completed
4 numerous projects of benefit to local residents; members have
5 started baseball and no-contact football teams for young people,
6 and every year they provide baseball uniform shirts to any children
7 in Muenster who want to play; other initiatives undertaken in
8 behalf of area youngsters include scholarships and a youth deer
9 hunt; and

10 WHEREAS, The Jaycees have also made outdoor recreational
11 space a priority; the group worked hard to build the city park,
12 installing a fence, planting grass, and providing playground
13 equipment, and members later added a pavilion and tennis and
14 volleyball courts; their most recent accomplishment is the
15 construction of a baseball complex, which so far has two fields with
16 lights and sprinkler systems, a concessions building, and batting
17 cages with pitching machines; and

18 WHEREAS, The Muenster Jaycees have further distinguished
19 themselves through their contributions to such organizations as the
20 American Heart Association, the American Red Cross, the United Way,
21 the Muscular Dystrophy Association, 4-H, the FFA, and the
22 Gainesville and Denton State Schools; and

23 WHEREAS, For 50 years, the members of the Muenster Jaycees
24 have enriched the lives of their fellow citizens through their

1 outstanding efforts, and the group is indeed deserving of
2 commendation for its record of achievement; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
4 Legislature hereby commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Muenster
5 Jaycees and extend to the members of this admirable organization
6 sincere best wishes for continued success; and, be it further
