- 7 Defense Superior Service Medal, the Legion of Merit with two oak
- 8 leaf clusters, the Bronze Star Medal with "V" device and the Bronze
- 9 Star Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Meritorious Service
- 10 Medal with five oak leaf clusters, the Army Commendation Medal, and
- 11 the Army Achievement Medal with three oak leaf clusters; and
