R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, A dedicated group of high school students in San  
2 Patricio County are making valuable contributions as part of the  
3 Texas 4-H Livestock Ambassador Program, and their efforts are  
4 indeed deserving of recognition; and

5           WHEREAS, The Texas 4-H Livestock Ambassador Program provides  
6 an opportunity for high-school-age members of the organization to  
7 develop advanced leadership skills and a greater knowledge of  
8 agriculture and agricultural careers; ambassadors receive special  
9 training in animal science principles and complete at least 30  
10 hours of community service and advocacy each year; they also serve  
11 as mentors to younger 4-H members; and

12           WHEREAS, In January 2013, the San Patricio County 4-H  
13 Livestock Ambassadors held the Extra Special Livestock Show at the  
14 county fairgrounds in Sinton for children and teens with special  
15 needs; individuals from six area school districts took part in the  
16 show, as well as students from George West in Live Oak County; more  
17 than 60 participants got the chance to show lambs and goats, and all  
18 received ribbons to commemorate their achievement; and

19           WHEREAS, The 10 San Patricio County 4-H Livestock Ambassadors  
20 are Kelsey Robinette, Corrina Mendez, Daniel Cullison, Jared  
21 Cullison, and Allison Vanecek of Gregory-Portland High School,  
22 Kristen Ulch of Aransas Pass High School, Allison Surginer and  
23 Jillian Williams of Sinton High School, and Luke Person of Mathis  
24 and Kellie Lopez of Ingleside, who are home-schooled; Texas
