- 1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to
- 2 recognize February 21, 2013, as Viva San Antonio Day at the State
- 3 Capitol and welcome the visiting delegation from the Alamo City;
- 4 and
- 5 WHEREAS, The history of San Antonio can be traced back to
- 6 1691, when a group of Spanish explorers and missionaries came upon a
- 7 river and named it San Antonio, in honor of Saint Anthony, whose
- 8 feast day was being celebrated; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The city was founded in 1718 by Father Antonio
- 10 Olivares; he established Mission San Antonio de Valero, which would
- 11 become etched in the annals of history in 1836 as the Alamo, the
- 12 site where 189 brave individuals held the mission for 13 days
- 13 against an army of some 4,000 Mexican soldiers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, The cry "Remember the Alamo" became the rallying
- 15 point of the Texas Revolution; today, the Alamo is a shrine and
- 16 museum and is widely recognized as the cradle of Texas liberty; and
- WHEREAS, San Antonio became formally incorporated in 1837,
- 18 when the fledgling Republic of Texas granted the city a charter; the
- 19 city has since retained its sense of history and tradition while
- 20 carefully blending in cosmopolitan progress; it has served and
- 21 continues to serve as a crossroads and a meeting place, where the
- 22 rich sounds and cultural influences of Native Americans, Old
- 23 Mexico, Germans, the Wild West, African Americans, and the Deep
- 24 South mingle and merge; and

No. 471 WHEREAS, The city has a proud military heritage; great 1 military figures like Pershing, Stilwell, Krueger, LeMay, 2 3 Chennault, and Eisenhower served at San Antonio military institutions, including Fort Sam Houston, the headquarters for the 4 5 U.S. Army North and U.S. Army South and Randolph Air Force Base, the home of Air Education Training Command; in addition, San Antonio is 6 the site of Lackland Air Force Base, the largest training wing in 7 8 the United States Air Force, and the San Antonio Military Health System, which oversees all U.S. military medical training; and 9 10 WHEREAS, Recent years have brought remarkable economic development to San Antonio as its skilled workforce, excellent 11 institutions of public and higher education, and quality of life 12 have attracted some important corporate business and industry to 13 14 the city; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The city's chambers of commerce serve as leading advocates for the business community and are dedicated to building 16 17 and sustaining San Antonio's diverse and prosperous economy; their efforts have been focused in the area's major local industries, 18 19 including health care, manufacturing, aerospace, information 20 technology, and cybersecurity; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Millions of visitors a year delight in the discovery of San Antonio; in addition to the Alamo, highlights include La 22 Villita, San Fernando Cathedral, San Antonio Missions Trail, and 23 24 the famed Paseo del Rio, better known as "The Riverwalk"; among the other attractions that make San Antonio one of the top tourist 25 26 destinations in the country are SeaWorld San Antonio and the Six Flags Fiesta Texas theme park as well as the PGA Tour Valero Texas 27

- 1 Open, the Alamo Bowl, and the four-time world champion San Antonio
- 2 Spurs; and
- 3 WHEREAS, In April 2013, the city will once again celebrate
- 4 Fiesta San Antonio, the biggest 11-day party in the state; first
- 5 held 120 years ago, the event was founded by a group of ladies who
- 6 decorated horse-drawn carriages for a parade in front of the Alamo
- 7 and battled with flower blossoms instead of bullets to honor the
- 8 heroes of the Alamo and the Battle of San Jacinto; and
- 9 WHEREAS, San Antonio is truly one of the treasures of the Lone
- 10 Star State, and Viva San Antonio Day provides a welcome opportunity
- 11 to honor the city and its many fine residents; now, therefore, be it
