2 of its own, Jesse Ancira, Jr., chief of staff for Speaker Joe  
3 Straus, who was named the 2012 Citizen of the Year by the Taylor  
4 Rotary Club; and

5           WHEREAS, A native of Taylor, Mr. Ancira graduated from Taylor  
6 High School and Southwest Texas State University before earning a  
7 law degree from The University of Texas; he soon returned to his  
8 beloved hometown, where he has served on the Taylor City Council and  
9 as president of the Taylor Independent School District Board of  
10 Trustees; Mr. Ancira has further given back to his community  
11 through his work as a member of the boards of the Our Lady of  
12 Guadalupe Catholic Church, the Taylor YMCA, and the Temple College  
13 at Taylor Foundation; additionally, he has been a member of the  
14 Literacy Council of Williamson County and co-chair of an initiative  
15 supporting a bond measure to construct a new high school; and

16           WHEREAS, Today, this notable Texan serves as chief of staff  
17 for Speaker Joe Straus, for whom he is also general counsel and  
18 senior tax and economic development advisor; before accepting his  
19 current job, he was an associate deputy comptroller and general  
20 counsel with the Office of the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts  
21 and a special agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

22           WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Mr. Ancira has been blessed  
23 with the support of a loving family, which includes his wife, Mary,  
24 and his children, "Trey" and "Alex"; and

2 individuals like Jesse Ancira, whose tireless work in behalf of  
3 area citizens has contributed immeasurably to the quality of life  
4 in Taylor and beyond; now, therefore, be it
