RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives joins the 2 citizens of Andrews County and Texans across the state in 3 celebrating February 20, 2013, as Andrews County Day at the State 4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Situated on the high plains of the Permian Basin, 6 Andrews County was established in 1876 and formally organized in 7 1910 with Andrews as its county seat; both the city and county are 8 named for Richard Andrews, an early settler and soldier in the 9 revolutionary army and the first man to die in the Texas War for 10 Independence in 1835; and

11 WHEREAS, Andrews County has long been a leader in the 12 ranching industry in Texas, and with the advent of the widespread use of windmills, the county became an important source of cotton 13 14 and sorghum; it experienced an impressive oil boom during the 1940s and has recently experienced the greatest period of growth and 15 16 development in its history; as the fastest growing micropolitan area in Texas, it remains one of the state's leading producers of 17 oil and gas, having just produced its three billionth barrel of oil 18 since 1929; and 19

20 WHEREAS, With unprecedented support from the citizens, 21 elected representatives, and civic organizations of the area, 22 Andrews County hosts the most advanced secure facility for the 23 disposal of Class A, B, and C low-level radioactive waste in the 24 United States; and

1 WHEREAS, The Andrews Independent School District is noted for 2 academic excellence, with its teams having earned top honors at 3 numerous University Interscholastic League academic competitions; 4 and

5 WHEREAS, The Andrews High School girls' golf team is the 6 two-time defending 3A State Champion, and both the boys' and girls' 7 golf teams are currently ranked number one in their conference; and 8 WHEREAS, The people of Andrews County enjoy an abundance of 9 recreational opportunities, including the Andrews County Golf 10 Course and many exemplary area parks; in addition, the county 11 boasts an annual bluegrass festival, and the Andrews Art Guild Show
