- 1 WHEREAS, Proud citizens of Victoria are gathering in Austin
- 2 on March 6, 2013, to celebrate Victoria Day at the State Capitol;
- 3 and
- WHEREAS, Founded in 1824 by Martin de Leon, the city was named
- 5 Guadalupe Victoria after the first president of Mexico; it was
- 6 renamed Victoria after the Texas Revolution and incorporated under
- 7 the Republic of Texas in 1839; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Later that century, Victoria became a major junction
- 9 on the routes between San Antonio, Austin, northern Mexico, and the
- 10 ports of the Gulf Coast, and at the same time developed into a
- 11 center for ranching; one of the first meat-packing plants was
- 12 established there in 1869; and
- WHEREAS, Today agribusiness, the petrochemical industry, and
- 14 tourism all contribute to the city's prosperity; in addition,
- 15 Victoria is an educational and cultural hub for the Coastal Bend;
- 16 students benefit from the outstanding teachers and scholars of
- 17 Victoria College and the University of Houston--Victoria, while
- 18 patrons delight in the annual seasons of the Victoria Ballet
- 19 Theatre, the Victoria Symphony, and Theatre Victoria, as well as
- 20 the exhibitions of contemporary art at the Nave Museum; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Victoria's rich history is evoked in artifacts
- 22 showcased at the Museum of the Coastal Bend and by the Romanesque
- 23 Revival architecture of the Victoria County Courthouse and the
- 24 O'Connor-Proctor Building; moreover, De Leon Plaza, one of four

- 1 public squares set aside by the city's founder, is filled with
- 2 monuments and memorials; other popular attractions include the
- 3 Texas Zoo, featuring more than 150 native animals, Riverside Park,
- 4 with more than 560 acres of woodland, and Fossati's Delicatessen,
- 5 the oldest deli in Texas; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Combining the best qualities of small-town life with
- 7 all the advantages of a thriving mid-size city, Victoria is one of
- 8 the treasures of the Lone Star State, and its appealing mix of
- 9 history and culture make it an excellent place to live, work, and
