1 WHEREAS, Texas A&M alumnus Dr. Steve O'Neal was inducted into 2 the American Football Kicking Hall of Fame on January 17, 2013; and 3 WHEREAS, The American Football Kicking Hall of Fame honors professional, college, and high school players who have shown 4 5 remarkable accomplishments as placekickers or punters in American football; and 6 WHEREAS, Born on February 4, 1946, in Hearne, Steve O'Neal 7 attended high school in that city before enrolling at Texas A&M 8 9 University, where for three consecutive years he lettered in football and track; in 1967, he was the leading punter in the 10

garnered national recognition for his outstanding performance by 13

following year, he was again selected for the All-SWC team and

Southwest Conference and earned All-Conference honors;

14 being named an All-American; moreover, his memorable play with the

Aggies was later honored with his selection as the punter for the 15

WHEREAS, Drafted by the New York Jets in 1969, he was playing 17 in just his second professional game when he lined up for a kick 18 while pinned deep in his own end zone; he launched the ball and 19 20 watched it travel 75 yards in the air before it hit the turf and 21 rolled, ultimately ending up on the opponent's one-yard line; the kick broke the old NFL record set in 1931, and the total distance of 22 23 98 yards still stands as the longest punt in pro football history; 24 and

- 1 WHEREAS, Over the course of his five-year professional 2 career, during which he played for the New Orleans Saints in 3 addition to the Jets, Steve O'Neal punted for more than 13,700 yards 4 while recording an average of 40.7 yards per kick; when his career 5 was cut short by a knee injury, he left the game and enrolled at the 6 University of Tennessee; he earned a degree in dentistry in 1974 and

- 8 WHEREAS, With his notable success at the collegiate and 9 professional levels and his record-breaking performance as a rookie 10 in the National Football League, Steve O'Neal has contributed to 11 the Lone Star State's tradition of athletic excellence, and he is
