- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of the Mid-Valley region of Texas
- 2 are gathering in Austin on February 27, 2013, to celebrate
- 3 Mid-Valley Day at the State Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, Located in eastern Hidalgo County in the Rio Grande
- 5 Valley, the Mid-Valley region includes the towns of Alamo, Donna,
- 6 Mercedes, Progreso, Progreso Lakes, San Juan, and Weslaco; this
- 7 area is a center for agribusiness, with farmers producing
- 8 sugarcane, grains, and citrus fruit such as grapefruits and
- 9 oranges; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The city of Alamo is located in proximity to the
- 11 Santa Ana National Wildlife Refuge, which comprises more than 2,000
- 12 acres of protected land and is home to a wide array of animals and
- 13 plants; in addition, the town boasts a birding information center
- 14 and the popular Alamo Central Park; and
- WHEREAS, Upholding the motto "the City with a Heart in the
- 16 Heart of the Rio Grande Valley," Donna serves as the location of the
- 17 Donna-Rio Bravo International Bridge, which helps to facilitate
- 18 shopping, tourism, and commercial trade to and from Mexico; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mercedes has long been a major center for the
- 20 processing and marketing of livestock, cotton, and vegetables, and
- 21 it is also known for its boot makers and the shopping opportunities
- 22 at the Rio Grande Valley Premium Outlets; the annual Rio Grande
- 23 Valley Livestock Show and Rodeo draws more than 200,000 people to
- 24 town each year, and the event provides valuable scholarship funds

- 1 for 4-H and FFA students; and
- 2 WHEREAS, In addition to being centers for the sugarcane
- 3 business, Progreso and Progreso Lakes have been serving as gateways
- 4 to the Rio Grande Valley since the opening of the Progreso/Nuevo
- 5 Progreso International Bridge in 2003; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Fast-growing San Juan is the home of the Basilica of
- 7 Our Lady of San Juan del Valle National Shrine, which attracts
- 8 multitudes of pilgrims from throughout the United States and
- 9 Mexico; the town hosts an annual Spring Fiesta and is the site of
- 10 numerous parks, including Liberty Park, with its flagpole monument
- 11 that honors those who have served in the U.S. armed forces; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The city of Weslaco has become a favorite
- 13 destination for tourists, golfers, retirees, and birders and is the
- 14 location of two important Texas A&M University research stations;
- 15 the annual Onion Fest celebrates the development of the famous
- 16 Texas 1015 onion in Weslaco, and this popular event brings many
- 17 visitors to the city; and
- WHEREAS, Throughout the Mid-Valley region, great emphasis is
- 19 placed on the value of education, and the Science Academy of South
- 20 Texas in Mercedes consistently ranks among the top 100 on
- 21 Newsweek's list of "America's Best High Schools"; and
- WHEREAS, The residents of this dynamic region of the Lone
- 23 Star State are justifiably proud of their hard work, civic
- 24 commitment, and innovative spirit, and their efforts have created a
- 25 group of notable Texas communities that are well prepared to meet
- 26 the challenges and opportunities of the future; now, therefore, be
