- 6 Mr. Edge served three terms as the representative from House
- 7 District 45, which covered Atascosa, Bandera, Frio, Live Oak,
- 8 Medina, and Wilson Counties; he was a member of the Agriculture and
- 9 Livestock Committee throughout his legislative tenure, and he was
- 10 appointed to the budget and oversight subcommittees of that
- 11 committee during the 70th Legislature and of the Public Education
- 12 Committee during the 71st Legislature; and
- WHEREAS, The son of Clyde and Minnie Edge, Eldon Edge was born
- 14 on his family's ranch in Kendalia on March 15, 1926, and spent his
- 15 childhood playing along the Pedernales River; after graduating from
- 16 high school, he answered his country's call to duty and served in
- 17 the United States Marine Corps during World War II; he earned a
- 18 degree in chemistry from Southwest Texas State Teachers College on
- 19 his return; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Edge taught in Hallettsville for a number of
- 21 years while working to obtain his master's degree in school
- 22 administration; he later became the superintendent of several
- 23 school districts, including Wortham, Riesel, Comfort, and Poth
