WHEREAS, Today, there are 125 KIPP schools in 20 states and the District of Columbia, and they have a combined enrollment of more than 41,000; more than 87 percent of the student population is from low-income families and more than 95 percent are racial minorities; after attending KIPP middle schools, more than 90
