21 Bend County, the Boy Scouts of America, the Fort Bend Economic
22 Development Council, and numerous chambers of commerce; during
23 retirement, he looks forward to spending more time with his family,
24 including his wife of almost 36 years, Helen, as well as their four

1 children and nine grandchildren; in addition, he will enjoy having
2 the leisure to work at his Trinity "A" Ranch in Madison and Leon
3 Counties; and

5 betterment of the Lone Star State, Joe Allen has won the respect and
6 admiration of his colleagues and fellow citizens, and he may indeed
7 reflect with pride on his significant accomplishments; now,
