1 WHEREAS, Members of the Cleburne Chamber of Commerce and the 2 Cleburne Tuesday Forum are visiting the State Capitol on March 5, 3 2013, and this occasion provides a welcome opportunity to pay 4 tribute to these two notable public-spirited organizations; and

5 WHEREAS, After a preliminary meeting held on December 20, 1918, the Cleburne Chamber of Commerce charter was approved on 6 7 February 17 of the following year; on March 21, at the organization's first regular meeting, 84 chamber members pledged to 8 9 give back to the city in which they worked and raised their families; during the ensuing decades, the chamber has focused on 10 11 the areas of industry and agriculture, emphasized the importance of 12 planning and community development, and worked closely with the North Texas Tollway Authority and the Texas Department 13 of 14 Transportation on the Chisholm Trail Parkway project to ensure positive growth for Cleburne and surrounding areas; currently, the 15 organization has more than 950 members and receives over 9,300 16 visitors and 12,000 phone calls per year; and 17

18 WHEREAS, The Cleburne Tuesday Forum is a nonprofit 19 association that provides a platform for public discussion of 20 issues that affect Johnson County; in existence for 40 years, the 21 forum is made up of business and professional men and women who meet 22 once a month to share information and exchange points of view; and

23 WHEREAS, The vision and leadership provided by the Cleburne 24 Chamber of Commerce and the Cleburne Tuesday Forum have played an

important role in the growth and vitality of their community, and the groups' efforts to foster a better informed and more engaged
