5 County, Leadership Southwest had 23 participants in its inaugural  
6 class of 1985, and over the ensuing 28 years it has graduated  
7 approximately 1,000 civic-minded individuals; the organization is  
8 a cooperative effort sponsored by the Cedar Hill, DeSoto,  
9 Duncanville, Lancaster, and Oak Cliff Chambers of Commerce that  
10 works to develop tomorrow's leaders and inspire the spirit of  
11 activism for the public good; and

13 critical issues facing the community and instruction from leaders  
14 on topics such as education, law enforcement, the arts, government,  
15 economic growth, health, and transportation; many participants go  
16 on to serve their fellow Texans on the boards of schools, hospitals,  
17 and other institutions or through elected offices; and

19 citizenry and to develop new leaders, Leadership Southwest is  
20 helping build a brighter and more prosperous future for the Lone
