WHEREAS, Mr. Munoz is CEO of Kell Munoz Architects, one of 10 the largest minority-owned architectural firms in the state, and he 11 12 serves as chair of the VIA Metropolitan Transit Authority; a prominent patron of the arts, he founded Museo Alameda, a San 13 14 Antonio museum that showcased Hispanic art, and he has shared his expertise on several advisory boards for the 15 Smithsonian 16 Institution, as well as with other museums and committees; moreover, he has been involved in numerous charitable projects, an 17 arena where his contributions include raising more than \$5 million 18 19 for scholarships; and

20 WHEREAS, Widely recognized for his accomplishments, he has 21 received such accolades as the Community Service Award from the San 22 Antonio Hispanic Chamber of Commerce and the Entrepreneur of the 23 Year Award from *Hispanic Business* magazine; and
