6 Washington, D.C., Chi Eta Phi is a national sorority of
7 professional registered nurses and nursing students that aims to
8 increase interest and develop leaders in the field; today, the
9 organization boasts more than 8,000 members, both male and female,
10 in over 90 graduate and 50 undergraduate chapters in 26 states, the
11 District of Columbia, the Virgin Islands, and Liberia; and

13 those designed to strengthen nursing student recruitment and
14 retention, disseminate new knowledge and best practices, and
15 promote health through preventative care; in addition to holding

18 for its diabetes, glaucoma awareness, and low vision projects, with
19 the National Cancer Institute for its National Black Leadership

23 educational organizations to better advance its mission; and
