11 WHEREAS, Quickly taking action, the team began knocking on 12 the doors of neighboring homes to find help; after 9-1-1 had been 13 called, the students worked to keep Ms. Whitcomb comfortable until 14 paramedics arrived to transport her to the hospital; and

15 WHEREAS, The compassion and sound judgment these students 16 demonstrated under pressure proved essential in helping a woman in 17 dire need, and their actions are indeed deserving of special 18 recognition; now, therefore, be it
