1 WHEREAS, Jimmy Griffin retired from the U.S. Postal Service
2 on January 31, 2013, drawing to a close a career in public service
3 that spanned three and a half decades; and

4 WHEREAS, After serving his country in the United States
5 Marine Corps, Mr. Griffin found employment with the post office;
6 hired in 1977, he initially worked nights as a mail handler in
7 Lufkin; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Griffin later became a mail carrier in
9 Nacogdoches, and over the course of his 21 years there, he delivered
10 mail on every route in the city, including one route that involved
11 10 miles of walking; he subsequently returned to Lufkin to become a
12 post office clerk, and he served as postmaster and supervisor as
13 well; and

14 WHEREAS, Jimmy Griffin demonstrated professionalism and
15 commitment throughout his notable tenure with the USPS, and he may
16 indeed reflect with pride on a career well spent as he embarks on
17 the next exciting chapter of his life; now, therefore, be it

19 Legislature hereby congratulate Jimmy Griffin on his retirement
20 from the U.S. Postal Service and extend to him sincere best wishes
