1           WHEREAS, Members of the Conner Harrington Republican Women of  
2 Plano have played an active role in their community and beyond for  
3 42 years; and

4           WHEREAS, Organized in the home of Gladys Harrington in 1971,  
5 this group of concerned citizens had 16 original members, united by  
6 a vision of small government and individual liberty and  
7 responsibility; the club was named for the late Conner Harrington,  
8 who served as mayor of Plano and as a member of the State Republican  
9 Executive Committee; and

10           WHEREAS, The Conner Harrington Republican Women began  
11 holding night meetings to allow working mothers to attend, and they  
12 conducted all business in an open format to ensure that everyone  
13 could participate; the club has won awards from the National and  
14 Texas Federations of Republican Women, and its members have gone on  
15 to win elected office and serve at the highest levels in the state  
16 federation and in the Republican Party of Texas; and

17           WHEREAS, Under the leadership of current president Pat  
18 Hatchell, members of the Conner Harrington Republican Women are  
19 making a lasting difference through their grassroots political  
20 activism, and they may take justifiable pride in their rich history  
21 of civic engagement and their reputation for vitality,  
22 congeniality, and camaraderie; now, therefore, be it
