2 the University Interscholastic League 5A state title on June 9,  
3 2012, reaching the pinnacle of success in its first appearance in

6 Consolidated High School in the title game at Dell Diamond in Round  
7 Rock, the Mustangs scored two quick runs in the first inning and  
8 then relied on pitchers Zach Brosch and Jonathan Whitley to hold the  
9 lead; sophomore center fielder Corbin Martin belted a home run en  
10 route to the team's 4-1 triumph, and he was named the state  
11 tournament 5A Most Valuable Player; and
