## RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month, and
- 2 2013 marks the 30th anniversary in which states join together to
- 3 promote greater protection of our children through increased public
- 4 awareness of and action against child abuse; and
- 5 WHEREAS, National Child Abuse Prevention Month was first
- 6 observed in April 1983, and in the years since, government agencies
- 7 and advocacy groups have continued to mark this month with a range
- 8 of initiatives that help target and stop abuse; and
- 9 WHEREAS, According to the Centers for Disease Control and
- 10 Prevention, approximately 700,000 U.S. children were victims of
- 11 abuse and neglect in 2010, and more than 1,500 died from
- 12 maltreatment; in Texas, Child Protective Services personnel
- 13 confirmed nearly 40,000 such cases and over 200 related fatalities
- 14 in 2011; the actual number of individuals suffering from abuse each
- 15 year is estimated to be far greater because many cases go unreported
- 16 or undetected; and
- WHEREAS, To help address this problem, organizations at the
- 18 local, state, and national levels have sponsored programs to
- 19 support families, to foster healthy parenting practices, and to
- 20 engage communities in prevention and intervention efforts; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Public awareness is one of the most important tools
- 22 in the fight to end child abuse and neglect; in observing National
- 23 Child Abuse Prevention Month, Texas stands alongside the rest of
- 24 the nation in defending the right of all children to grow up in a

- 1 safe and nurturing environment; now, therefore, be it
- 2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 3 Legislature hereby recognize April 2013 as National Child Abuse
- 4 Prevention Month and call on all citizens to work together to ensure
