WHEREAS, The First National Bank in Hebbronville is
celebrating its centennial in 2013; and

3 WHEREAS, Established on May 23, 1913, as the Hebbronville 4 State Bank, the institution was originally located on a site on 5 Texas Avenue donated by Oscar Thompson, a founding director; it was 6 chartered on July 23 of that year with paid-in capital of \$25,000; 7 and

8 WHEREAS, A new building was constructed on Galbraith Street 9 in 1924, and two years later the bank adopted its present-day name; 10 it opened its first drive-up window in 1973, and a little more than 11 a decade later, it moved to its current location on Smith Street; 12 and

WHEREAS, Led by president and chief executive officer Israel Hinojosa, the bank today has over \$138 million in assets, and it employs 9 officers and 15 other staff members; for 96 consecutive quarters, it has earned a five-star rating from BauerFinancial, Inc., which places it among the elite group of Sustained Superiority Banks, a distinction held by only three percent of the nation's banking institutions; and
