R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The First National Bank in Hebbroville is  
2 celebrating its centennial in 2013; and

3           WHEREAS, Established on May 23, 1913, as the Hebbroville  
4 State Bank, the institution was originally located on a site on  
5 Texas Avenue donated by Oscar Thompson, a founding director; it was  
6 chartered on July 23 of that year with paid-in capital of \$25,000;  
7 and

8           WHEREAS, A new building was constructed on Galbraith Street  
9 in 1924, and two years later the bank adopted its present-day name;  
10 it opened its first drive-up window in 1973, and a little more than  
11 a decade later, it moved to its current location on Smith Street;  
12 and

13           WHEREAS, Led by president and chief executive officer Israel  
14 Hinojosa, the bank today has over \$138 million in assets, and it  
15 employs 9 officers and 15 other staff members; for 96 consecutive  
16 quarters, it has earned a five-star rating from BauerFinancial,  
17 Inc., which places it among the elite group of Sustained  
18 Superiority Banks, a distinction held by only three percent of the  
19 nation's banking institutions; and

20           WHEREAS, Businesses that employ Texans and contribute to  
21 local economies are important components of a prosperous future,  
22 and for the past century, First National Bank has played an  
23 essential role in the Hebbroville community; now, therefore, be it
