RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The Texas Parks and Wildlife Department is marking
- 2 its 50th anniversary in 2013, and this milestone provides a fitting
- 3 opportunity to recognize its accomplishments; and
- WHEREAS, On August 23, 1963, the 58th Texas Legislature
- 5 merged the operations of the Texas Game and Fish Commission and the
- 6 State Parks Board to create the Parks and Wildlife Department; the
- 7 new agency's first challenge was to improve and expand the park
- 8 system, and between 1968 and 1976, the acreage of parkland owned by
- 9 the state was nearly doubled; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Parks and Wildlife assumed responsibility for the
- 11 administration of the Texas Water Safety Act and of the Land and
- 12 Water Conservation Fund beginning in the 1960s and later
- 13 implemented the provisions of the Texas Endangered Species and
- 14 Wildlife Conservation Acts; and
- WHEREAS, By the late 1980s, the Texas parks system
- 16 encompassed well over 400,000 acres, including parks, natural
- 17 areas, and historic sites; the department also protected and
- 18 managed the fish population in more than 600 public reservoirs and
- 19 16,000 miles of streams and rivers, as well as along 370 miles of
- 20 coastline; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Park use continued to rise, with more than 20
- 22 million people visiting on an annual basis by the 1990s; the
- 23 agency's staff and administration have worked diligently through
- 24 the years to meet the challenges presented by population growth and

- 1 urbanization, partnering with diverse entities to conserve natural
- 2 and cultural resources and enhance opportunities for outdoor
- 3 recreation; and
- WHEREAS, Over the past half-century, the vital endeavors of
- 5 the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department have enriched the lives of
- 6 innumerable citizens, and the agency has earned the profound
- 7 appreciation of all who treasure the natural beauty of the Lone Star
- 8 State; now, therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas
- 10 Legislature hereby commemorate the 50th anniversary of the
- 11 establishment of the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department and honor
- 12 the staff and administration for their hard work and dedication on
- 13 its behalf; and, be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
- 15 prepared for the department as an expression of high regard by the
- 16 Texas House of Representatives.
