1           WHEREAS, Dale Jaecks retired from the Milam County  
2 Commissioners Court on December 31, 2012, drawing to a close a  
3 distinguished tenure in public service that spanned four decades;  
4 and

5           WHEREAS, First elected to Milam County Commissioners Court  
6 Precinct 3 in 1988, Commissioner Jaecks worked to modernize and  
7 improve roadways and bridges throughout Precinct 3; during his  
8 tenure, he oversaw the replacement of all the wooden bridges in  
9 Precinct 3, and his leadership was integral in the restoration of  
10 Sugarloaf Bridge in Milam County; and

11           WHEREAS, His tireless commitment to public service led Mr.  
12 Jaecks to serve on the board of the Central Texas Council of  
13 Governments for over 22 years and as chairman for 3 years; he also  
14 served as president of the Texas Association of Regional Councils,  
15 vice president of the Hill Country Community Action Association,  
16 and Milam County judge pro tem; and

17           WHEREAS, This esteemed Texan earned the Wilbur R. Dunk  
18 Regional Leadership Award for his extraordinary dedication to the  
19 purposes and possibilities of regional cooperation through  
20 councils of governments in Texas; and

21           WHEREAS, Commissioner Jaecks has demonstrated an outstanding  
22 record of public service and civic engagement, and in so doing, he  
23 has helped to make Milam County an even better place in which to  
24 live and work; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 83rd Texas  
2 Legislature hereby congratulate Commissioner Dale Jaecks on his  
3 retirement from the Milam County Commissioners Court and extend to  
4 him sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

5           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
6 prepared for Commissioner Jaecks as an expression of high regard by  
7 the Texas House of Representatives.
