## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Burleson Area Chamber of Commerce are 2 visiting the State Capitol on March 19, 2013, and this occasion 3 provides a fitting opportunity to pay tribute to this outstanding 4 organization and the city it serves; and

5 WHEREAS, The Burleson Chamber traces its history to 1965, 6 when 75 members of the Lions Club came together to discuss economic 7 and industrial development and realized the need for a permanent 8 organization; the chamber was officially founded on April 18 of the 9 following year; and

WHEREAS, In the years since, the Burleson Chamber has played a leading role in the life of the city, sponsoring ongoing events and programs to benefit local businesses, as well as supporting charity fund-raisers and other community initiatives to make Burleson an even better place to live, work, and play; and

22 WHEREAS, The Burleson Independent School District includes 3 23 high schools, 2 middle schools, and 10 elementary schools, many of 24 which have been rated as Recognized or Exemplary by the Texas
