16 WHEREAS, In 1938, she married Charles Raymond Belding, and the couple were blessed with three daughters, Robyn, Rayna, and 17 Judy; Mr. and Mrs. Belding shared nearly five decades together 18 before Mr. Belding passed away in 1984; fortunate enough to find 19 20 love again, she married her high school sweetheart, Tom Hubbard, in 21 1988, and they enjoyed many happy years before his death; in 2003, at the age of 90, she married James Blew, and although he passed 22 23 away later that same year, their brief time together remains a source of many fond memories; and 24
