- 16 6,000 employees of municipal courts work diligently to ensure the
- 17 fair administration of justice while upholding the rigorous
- 18 standards of professionalism; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Municipal judges, clerks, court administrators,
- 20 bailiffs, and warrant officers continually strive to improve the
- 21 administration of justice through participation in judicial
- 22 education programs, seminars, workshops, and the annual meetings of
- 23 their state and local professional organizations; and
