1 WHEREAS, The mock trial team from Americas High School in
2 El Paso took first place in the Region 19 Texas High School Mock
3 Trial Competition, held on February 1 and 2, 2013, marking the
4 school's fifth consecutive win in the event; and

5 WHEREAS, This year's contest included teams from numerous
6 El Paso-area schools, each of which argued a hypothetical civil
7 case before judges and lawyers at the El Paso County Courthouse;
8 students from Americas High School have consistently turned in
9 strong performances at the regionals, and the 2011 team went on to
10 place first in the state and fifth in the national competition; and

11 WHEREAS, The members of the 2013 team are Victoria Espinoza,
12 Hannah Legge, Andrea Olivas, Jacob Parsont, MaryJane Plote, Denise
13 Ramirez, Seth Rappe, Michael Rodela, Viridiana Santacruz, and Isaac
14 Tarango; they were ably supported by coach Teresa M. Candelaria and
15 attorney advisors Jaime Esparza and Kyle Myers; with its victory,
16 the team earned the opportunity to advance to the state competition
17 taking place in Dallas in March; and
