2 at River Valley Intermediate School in McGregor, has been chosen as
3 a finalist for the 2013 Presidential Award for Excellence in
4 Mathematics and Science Teaching; and

6 through sixth-grade math and science teachers for innovation in the
7 classroom; the awards program is administered by the National
8 Science Foundation on behalf of the White House Office of Science
