6 Wallace was the son of Frank Glenn and Sheridan Lynne Loree Wallace;
7 he loved his work as a firefighter and paramedic in Bryan and served
8 with the department for 13 years; he was honored by the 100 Club in
9 2010 for his bravery in battling a blaze the previous year; and

10 WHEREAS, Lieutenant Wallace belonged to the International
11 Association of Firefighters Local No. 1203 and was a member of the
12 Marlin Lodge No. 152 A.F. & A.M., the Marlin Men's Civic
13 Association, and the First Baptist Church; he was an avid hunter as
14 well; and

15 WHEREAS, In all of his endeavors, Lieutenant Wallace enjoyed
16 the love and support of his wife, Brandie Wallace, and he was the
17 devoted father of five children, Matthew, R. C., Barrett, Paige,
18 and Isabell; he coached his children's sports teams and took great
19 pleasure in his role as a family man; and

20 WHEREAS, Eric Wallace distinguished himself through his
21 remarkable courage and his dedication to duty; although his life
22 ended far too soon, he leaves behind a legacy that will be forever
23 treasured by those who were privileged to know him; now, therefore,
