1 WHEREAS, Colin Hunter Paul of Boy Scouts of America Troop
2 No. 405 in Georgetown has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a small fraction of those who enter the
6 scouting movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding
7 criteria, Mr. Paul earned 28 merit badges and completed an Eagle
8 Scout project that included collecting and retiring 884 worn
9 U.S. flags and culminated in a ceremony at Sun City's Memorial Park
10 on September 11, 2011; and

12 congregant of Faith Lutheran Church, this fine young Texan has

17 his troop to receive a Medal of Merit, an honor he earned for saving

20 perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy to
21 stand among scouting's elite, and he may indeed reflect with pride
22 on a job well done; now, therefore, be it
