## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of Dixie Missionary Baptist Church in Jasper

2 are marking the 160th anniversary of the founding of their church in

3 July 2013; and

4 WHEREAS, Thought to be the oldest African American house of

5 worship in Texas, Dixie Missionary Baptist Church was organized

6 around 1850 under the leadership of Richard Seale, who also served

7 as its first pastor; and

8 WHEREAS, Dick Seale was born a slave in Virginia in 1798 and

9 moved to Texas in 1850 with his master, who established a plantation

10 west of Jasper near Bevilport; Mr. Seale was a devout Christian who

11 had acquired an education as a child, and he was much in demand to

12 conduct Bible readings and to attend to the spiritual needs of the

13 local African American community; he held his first formal

14 devotionals under a beech tree before a sanctuary was constructed

15 in 1853; part of that original structure stood until 1967 and was

16 awarded a historic building medallion, and today the Dixie

17 Missionary congregation of 500 still worships in a sanctuary at the

18 same location; and

19 WHEREAS, Through the years, the church has benefited from the

20 dedicated efforts of many outstanding clergymen; the list of

21 distinguished men who preceded the current pastor, the Reverend

22 Barry Keys, includes Reverends Griner, Grigsby, Reed, Brown,

23 Peacock, Bridges, Gipson, and Norsworthy; and

24 WHEREAS, Dixie Missionary Baptist Church has long served as a

- 1 source of inspiration and guidance to those who worship there, and
- 2 its continued existence is a tribute to the unwavering commitment
- 3 of its members and leaders, both past and present; now, therefore,
