WHEREAS, Since 1995, the H-E-B Sports Hall of Fame has paid tribute to individuals and teams who have made a positive impact in the community through sports-related endeavors; the hall was created to acknowledge successful teams and athletes as well as officials, administrators, trainers, medical practitioners, media figures, and others who have distinguished themselves with their achievements; and

11 WHEREAS, Junior Filikitonga attended Midway Park Elementary 12 and Central Junior High in Euless before becoming a standout 13 athlete at Trinity High School; he earned all-district and 14 all-region honors in track-and-field and football, qualified for 15 the state meet in the shot put and discus, and was chosen to play in 16 a North-South All-Star football game as a result of his exceptional 17 performance as a defensive end for the Trojans; and

WHEREAS, Continuing his football career at the collegiate level, Mr. Filikitonga was named an All-American while playing at Tyler Junior College; he then joined the Abilene Christian University team for two seasons, during which he became the fifth all-time leading tackler for the Wildcats and earned several significant accolades; in 1997, he was selected as the Lone Star Conference Defensive Lineman of the Year and a first team

1 All-American, and the following year he became a finalist for the 2 Harlon Hill Trophy, given to the NCAA Division II player of the 3 year; and
